## CHRIST THE KING HIGH SCHOOL JUNIOR HIGH HONOURS

At the start of the year it is important to communicate how students can achieve honours standing. Below is the method that we employ along with a sample calculation for a Junior High student. If you have any questions, about the average mark calculation, please contact us at the school.

## JUNIOR HIGH HONOURS

Junior High Honours are calculated according to the following weighted averaging method:

| JUNIOR HIGH COURSE | Weighting |
| :--- | :---: |
| Mathematics | 4 |
| Language Arts | 4 |
| Social Studies | 4 |
| Science | 4 |
| Religious Studies | 4 |

Example: A grade 9 student has the following marks:

| COURSE | Mark | Weighting | Weighting <br> Adjustment |
| :--- | :---: | :---: | :---: |
| Mathematics 9 | $83 \%$ | 4 | $83 \times 4$ |
| Language Arts 9 | $76 \%$ | 4 | $76 \times 4$ |
| Social Studies 9 | $91 \%$ | 4 | $91 \times 4$ |
| Science 9 | $85 \%$ | 4 | $85 \times 4$ |
| Religious Studies 9 | $72 \%$ | 4 | $72 \times 4$ |
| TOTAL |  | $\mathbf{2 0}$ | $\mathbf{1 6 2 8}$ |

The average calculation for the above student would be:

## $1628 \div 20$ or $81.4 \%$

and the student would qualify for honours
