## CHRIST THE KING JR/SR HIGH SCHOOL JUNIOR and SENIOR HIGH HONOURS

At the start of the year it is important to communicate how students can achieve honours standing. Below is the method that we employ along with a sample calculation for a Junior High and Senior High student. ## JUNIOR HIGH HONOURS

Junior High Honours are calculated according to the following weighted averaging method:

| JUNIOR HIGH COURSE | Weighting |
| :--- | :---: |
| Mathematics | 4 |
| Language Arts | 4 |
| Social Studies | 4 |
| Science | 4 |
| Religious Studies | 4 |
| Physical Education/Health | 4 |
| Jr. High Electives (depending on time) | $0.25 / 0.5$ or 1.0 |

Example: A grade 7 student has the following marks:

| COURSE | Mark | Weighting | Weighting <br> Adjustment |
| :--- | :---: | :---: | :---: |
| Mathematics 7 | $83 \%$ | 4 | $83 \times 4$ |
| Language Arts 7 | $76 \%$ | 4 | $76 \times 4$ |
| Social Studies 7 | $91 \%$ | 4 | $91 \times 4$ |
| Science 7 | $85 \%$ | 4 | $85 \times 4$ |
| Religious Studies 7 | $72 \%$ | 4 | $72 \times 4$ |
| Physical Education/Health 7 | $68 \%$ | 4 | $74 \times 4$ |
| French 7 (full-year option) | $82 \%$ | 1.0 | $82 \times 1.0$ |
| Drama 7 (semestered option) | $90 \%$ | 0.5 | $90 \times 0.5$ |
| Art 7 (quarterly option) | $75 \%$ | 0.25 | $75 \times 0.25$ |
| TOTAL |  | $\mathbf{2 5 . 7 5}$ | $\mathbf{2 0 6 9 . 7 5}$ |

The average calculation for the above student would be:

## $\mathbf{2 0 6 9 . 7 5} \div \mathbf{2 5 . 7 5}$ or $\mathbf{8 0 . 4 \%}$

and the student would qualify for honours!


## SENIOR HIGH HONOURS

Senior High Honours are calculated according to the following weighted averaging method. Although we place a high value on our Sr. High Elective courses, only the following courses count towards achieving Honours status:

| SENIOR HIGH Course | Weighting |
| :--- | :---: |
| Mathematics 10A/10P/14/20A/20P/24/30A/30P | 1 |
| English Language Arts 10-1/10-2/20-1/20-2/30-1/30-2 | 1 |
| Social Studies 10/13/20/23/30/33 | 1 |
| Science 10, Biology 20/30, Physics 20/30, Chemistry 20/30 | 1 |
| Religious Studies 15/25/35 | 1 |
| Physical Education 10 | 0.5 |
| CALM 20 | 0.5 |

Example: A grade 11 student has the following courses and marks for semester 1:

| COURSE | Mark | Weighting | Weighting <br> Adjustment |
| :--- | :---: | :---: | :---: |
| Mathematics 20P | $83 \%$ | 1 | $83 \times 1$ |
| Social Studies 20 | $76 \%$ | 1 | $76 \times 1$ |
| Religious Studies 25 | $91 \%$ | 1 | $91 \times 1$ |
| Info. Pro. | $85 \%$ | 0 | - |
| Art 20 | $72 \%$ | 0 | - |
| Physical Education 20 | $68 \%$ | 0 | - |
| TOTAL |  | $\mathbf{3}$ | $\mathbf{2 5 0}$ |

The average calculation for the above student would be:

$$
250 \div 3 \text { or } 83.3 \%
$$

and the student would qualify for $1^{\text {st }}$ semester Honours!
