- Enrollment if up approximately 11 students from projected enrollment
- Retention from grade 9 to grade 10 is trending up. Approximately 72%. This is great to see. Some strategies we are working on to improve that is creating a BHAG of making sure every student in the school has an adult that they have developed some sort of connection with.

- We are seeing a trend of students who have left in grade 10 and are coming back for 11 and 12
- We are seeing a trend in larger class sizes; this is due to funding based on the 3-year rolling average of the government, but we are making do.
- Sports teams have started. Senior teams compete in Edmonton Metro Athletics and our grade 9 teams compete in LDAA.
- Our welcome back BBQ was a huge success. We did not know what to expect, but it was well attended especially from the grade 9 families. We will be doing it next year.
- Christ the King was proud to work with the Parish in their running of the Feast of St.
 Michael. I know that it is goal from Senior Admin to focus on building those relationships with the Parish
