Christ The King & Outreach Exam Rules

- All in class finals are scheduled during regular class times unless otherwise posted.
- Students must be in the examination room at least 10 minutes before exams begin.
- All exams have a specific writing time allocated. All exam times listed include the DOUBLE time allotted for students.
- In the event that your child's bus is not running, Students will be responsible for getting to the school and attending exams.
There will be no rescheduling of final exams.
- Students are not allowed to be late or miss an exam.
- Cell phones, electronic device (i.e. smart watches, etc.) and backpacks are prohibited in exam rooms. They will NOT be allowed in the exam room. If students have a backpack, they can put it in their locker or may be dropped off to supervisors in the gym.
- Computers and calculators: If you are writing an exam that requires a computer, there will be no internet or personal folder access. The use of a computer must be approved by the teacher.
- If calculators are permitted, exam supervisors will clear all memory on the calculator. Students are responsible for providing their own calculator for exams.
- Students who must leave and return during an exam for any reason must be escorted by a staff member.
- Students must remain writing for a minimum of one hour.
- The Final Exam Schedule dates are in effect June 16th – June 23rd. All students will be expected to leave campus at the conclusion of their exam. If parents wish their child to remain on campus for study purposes in the library, please notify the Main Office describing the details of the request.
